

THE PROTOCOL OF THE SESSION OF THE AWARDING COMMITTEE OF THE 16th INTERNATIONAL CRIMEAN CONFERENCE “COSMOS AND BIOSPHERE”

1. The Program and Organizing Committee on 16th International Crimean conference “Cosmos and Biosphere” accepted decision to form a Work Award Committee (WAC) for Benveniste Association Awarding of the best reporter. The members of the Program Committee are:

2. After discussion the members of WAC accepted the next criteria for awarding:

1. the scientific report should be devoted to the study of the influence of physical factors on the biological system;
2. the scientific report should be devoted to the ecological problems of the biosphere and near-Earth outer space;
3. one of the main ideas of the report should be the role of water as a "sensor" of low-intensity physical and chemical factors and/or in the effects of space weather;
4. the results of the work will explain the possible mechanisms of the influence of physical or chemical factors on the biological system, space weather on biological systems and physico-chemical processes;
5. scientific works should be experimental in nature and be promising for future research.
